### 2019 Leavers' Photo

We would love all our leavers to be in the photo so, if your child does not normally attend on a Wednesday morning, please bring them in at 9.00am so that they can be in the photo.

You will need to wait with your child whilst the photo is taken.

### Pre-school Parents' evenings

Parents' evenings are on the 27th and 28th March. If you wish to come in and meet with your child's keyworker, we will be booking appointments from next week. If you don't do drop off / collection, please email or call the Teatimers office during pre-school hours.

### Bags & Pegs

Your child has a peg in the lobby for their Teatimers bag and coat.

The peg is yours for the duration of the session, but you must take everything home with you. Up to 80 other children will use those pegs between 3pm and 9am. If left here, your child's possessions will inevitably end up on the wrong peg or in lost property!

### End of term

This term finishes at 12.00pm on Friday 5 April. There is no afternoon Pre-school on this day and you will not be charged for the afternoon session. Pre-school returns on Wednesday 24 April.

## **Toys from home**

Please do not let your child bring toys from home into Pre-school. Unless you think your child may need a comforter during the session (which can be left in their Teatimers bag) then all other toys should be taken home with parents.

## **Footwear**

Our yoga, P.E. and dance sessions are all done in bare feet. To help encourage independence, particularly for the children going to school this September, it would help if your child had shoes they can put on and off themselves. Velcro fastenings are much easier than laces for little hands!
