



Teatimers – Pre-school Keyworker & Playworker

An exciting opportunity has arisen for a Level 2 or 3 qualified practitioner at Teatimers, a lively, thriving Pre-school and wraparound care provider in Marlow. You will be passionate about children's development and helping them develop their potential. You will also love the interaction with older children (up to age 11) whilst they are at play.

We pride ourselves on providing a fun, friendly and caring service for our children and families. Our setting gives a warm welcome to everyone who enters, and we feel proud when children do not want to leave.

We offer the following services to families in our own building in the grounds of Sandygate School in Marlow.

- Pre-School. Morning and afternoon care during term time, for up to 32 children per session.
- Wraparound (Breakfast and After School) sessions for primary school age children.

Job Description

To deliver a fun, caring early years education to a high standard within our Pre-school. You will be a keyworker, jointly responsible for a group of children. You will plan engaging activities for your keywork group, observe their achievements and assess their ongoing progress. You will be trained to use our online journal system and assist the whole team to create exciting weekly/longer term plans and themes for the setting.

Our wraparound clubs are about children having fun and being themselves whilst in our care. Wraparound is very rewarding and as much fun for the adults providing the care as the children. The role is to give them a great time at Teatimers, by helping them engage and interact with each other and in play. Some children spend a significant part of their free time with us, and we provide them a home from home environment with an extended family of children and adults to play with.

Hours

The position is offered as a 52 week contract, up to 42hrs hours per week. Ideally the days per week worked will be Tues-Fri, 7.30am-6pm but we have flexibility to discuss fewer days / hours.

Applicants who only want work in Pre-School hours (9-3) will not be considered for this role. You must be able to work in wraparound sessions (7.30 – 8.45 and 15:30-18:00)

Other

- Your child(ren) can come with you to wraparound care with no charge.
- Staff discount if you use us when you are not working or for Pre-school sessions.
- We operate a routine review process to help you develop your career and skills.
 - We will train you in First aid, safeguarding and food hygiene.
 - Additional training to help your development within childcare and early years.
 - Uniform is provided (at our expense)
 - A DBS check is required. We pay for this and your ongoing subscription to the update service.
